Christ the Cornerstone

In ancient building practices, the cornerstone is the first and most important stone set in the construction of a building's foundation. It serves two main purposes: 1) structural stability where it carries most of the building's weight and joins the walls together and 2) positional alignment where it determines the alignment and direction of the whole building. The cornerstone is not just another rock—it is a reference point, the foundation and the unifying piece for the rest of the building.

In the Bible, Jesus has often been described as the cornerstone of the Christian faith. Isaiah 28:16 tells us, "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; the one who relies on it will never be stricken with panic." And likewise, Ephesians 2:20 teaches us that the Church is "built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone." In our passage, 1 Peter 2:4-10, Peter is consistent in this description of Jesus. He reminds believers that Jesus is the living Cornerstone, chosen by God and essential to our faith. As followers of Christ and as part of the Church, we are like "living stones" that are being built upon him. This means that our lives take direction from our Lord Jesus.

Yet, if we are honest, we often build our lives on other "stones" or idols such as our careers, relationships, achievements, or financial security. These things may seem stable for a time, but they eventually shift or crumble when circumstances change. When they do, feelings of anxiety, restlessness, or insecurity can easily overwhelm us. However, when our foundation is in Jesus Christ, we will experience steadfast peace because he is unshakable. When the storms of life come, his steadfastness holds us steady. When uncertainty clouds our path, his word gives us wisdom, comfort, and peace. He is the solid rock beneath our feet when all else gives way. "The one who trusts in him will never be put to shame." (v6)

Building your faith in Jesus means trusting him with every part of your life and submitting your identity, your relationships and your future to him. Take a moment to reflect today: Are there areas of my life that I need to realign and surrender to Christ as my Cornerstone? Submit them to God in prayer, and let him work and guide you accordingly.

Pray the following for M.Y. Manna (a few of our members volunteer with them to deliver food and groceries to low-income beneficiaries):


- * Pray for God's wisdom and hand upon the team as they look into revamping M.Y. Manna to increase their outreach to low-income families.
